



## **ACCOMPLISHMENT REPORT ON THE INSTALLATION OF CLOSED-CIRCUIT TELEVISION (CCTV) SYSTEM SY 2025-2026**

### **I. RATIONALE**

To ensure the continued safety and security of pupils, teachers, and school property, the GPTA recognizes the need to replace eight outdated CCTV cameras/units. The existing cameras have shown signs of wear, poor resolution, and inconsistent recording, making them unreliable for effective monitoring. Upgrading to newer CCTV systems will enhance surveillance coverage, image clarity, and storage capabilities. This initiative aligns with the GPTA's commitment to maintaining a child-friendly and secure learning environment. It also supports the school's efforts in promoting safety, disaster preparedness, and incident response within school premises.

### **II. OBJECTIVES**

The new closed-circuit television (CCTV) system cameras were installed to:

1. enhance the security and safety of the school premises by replacing outdated CCTV cameras with high-resolution and fully functional units,
2. ensure continuous and reliable monitoring of critical areas such as entrances, hallways, offices, and other vulnerable points within the school vicinity, and
3. upgrade the school's surveillance system in compliance with current safety and disaster preparedness standards.

### **III. NARRATIVE ACCOMPLISHMENT REPORT**

To strengthen the school's safety and security measures, eight (8) new CCTV camera units were successfully installed in key locations within the school premises on July 23, 2025, from 9:30 AM to 3:00 PM. The new units were strategically placed to ensure comprehensive surveillance coverage in vital areas: two (2) units at the Genesis Hall, two (2) at the main entrance, one (1) in front of the church, one (1) along the hallway leading to the quadrangle, and two (2) units within the quadrangle area.

The installation was made possible through the generous assistance of one of our parents in the person of Mr. Ronald Manzon, who rendered the service free of charge. The project initial cost was ₱10,700.00, but the actual cost was ₱11,719.00. The installation was completed successfully without any professional labor cost.

Key individuals present during the installation were Mr. Carlos La-us, Officer-In-Charge of the Office of the Principal; the GPTA officers led by Mr. Arniel Campos, GPTA President; and the guard on duty, and also our book keeper who helped during the process. The installation team was also graciously supported with lunch and snacks, which were provided and personally shouldered by Mr. Arniel Campos and Ms. Anna Lorraine Bayangan.

This accomplishment reflects the collaborative effort of the school leadership, the GPTA, and the school community, demonstrating a shared commitment to creating a safe and secure learning environment for all.
